- Entry is open to the following individuals and groups in the London Borough of Croydon .
There are FOUR categories of entry:
 - Residents of Croydon
 - Schools and Colleges
 - Faith Groups
 - Businesses
- To enter in the Resident's category you must be aged 18 or over and a resident of the London Borough of Croydon. If someone under 18 is entering, you must have a person aged 18 or over submitting on their behalf. If submitting as part of a school, college, faith group, or business then its address must be within the boundaries of the London Borough of Croydon.
- Entries will be displayed on the CCA website (www.croydonclimateaction.com) and members of the public will vote online to select the shortlist for each category. The finalists will be selected from this list by the Croydon Climate Action team and 2 Councillors.
- There will be a first-place prize and 2 runners up in each category.
- If your photograph shows people who can be identified within it (i.e. their faces are showing), you must have written consent or a signed waiver from each person (or, if aged under 13, their parent or carer) which allows you to submit their photo and text to this competition and in Croydon Goes Wild exhibitions online, in libraries and other public spaces in Croydon. If you are unable to provide this documentation on request, your entry will be disallowed.
- One entry per resident or organisation.
- All entries will need to be received to us between 23rd August and 17th September 2022. Voting will open to the public between 18th and 25th September 2022.

- The final winners will be announced on the CCA website on Sunday 26th September 2022 and winners and runners up will be contacted by email.
- You retain full intellectual property rights over your photograph and text but give permission for CCA to display it on our website for no more than 12 months, unless you notify us of your decision to withdraw from the competition. Winning entries could be displayed permanently.

- Photos and text containing horror or graphic images, racial or sexual content, discriminatory depictions or language will be excluded.
